

How to get there: Driving directions to Huntington medical facilities

Patients from a wide region in West Virginia, Ohio and Kentucky travel to Huntington to receive medical care. Here are driving directions to reach Cabell Huntington Hospital (and Marshall University Medical Center) and St. Mary's Medical Center from different directions.

From Logan, WV:

To St. Mary's Medical Center: Take Route 119 North from Logan approximately 50 miles. Take exit ramp to I-64 West to Huntington. Once on I-64 West, it is 41 miles to Exit # 15 to 29th Street (Route 60). Make a right onto Route 60 West (turns into 31st Street), go 3.4 miles to 3rd Avenue. Turn left, go 2 blocks and turn right on 29th Street to hospital and outpatient center.

To Cabell Huntington Hospital: Take Route 119 North from Logan approximately 50 miles. Take exit ramp to I-64 West to Huntington. Once on I-64 West, it is 44 miles to Exit # 11, Hal Greer Boulevard (16th Street). Make a right turn at the bottom of the exit ramp. It is 1.6 miles to the entrance of the hospital and medical center on your right.

From Williamson, WV, and South Williamson, KY:

To Cabell Huntington Hospital: Take Route 119 North to Route 52 North Exit to Huntington. Stay on Route 52 North for 71 miles. Take I-64 East for 9 miles to Exit #11, Hal Greer Boulevard (16th Street). Turn left at the bottom of exit ramp. It is 1.8 miles to the entrance of the hospital and medical center on your right.

To St. Mary's Medical Center: Take Route 119 North to Route 52 North Exit to Huntington. Stay on Route 52 North for 71 miles. Take I-64 East for 12 miles to Exit #15, to 29th Street (Route 60 turns into 31st Street). Make a left turn at the bottom of the exit ramp onto Route 60 West, and go 3.4 miles to 3rd Avenue. Turn left, go 2 blocks and turn right on 29th Street to hospital and outpatient center.

From Point Pleasant, WV:

To St. Mary's Medical Center: Take Route 2 South to Huntington. Travel through Guyandotte, passing through the flood wall into Huntington; Route 2 then becomes 3rd Avenue. Turn Right at 29th Street to hospital and outpatient center.

To Cabell Huntington Hospital: Take Route 2 South to Huntington. Travel through Guyandotte, passing through the flood wall into Huntington; Route 2 then becomes 3rd Avenue. Continue West 2 miles to Hal Greer Boulevard (16th Street). Turn left, go 1.2 miles to the hospital and medical center on your left.

From Ironton, OH, and Ashland, KY:

To Cabell Huntington Hospital: Take Route 52 East to I-64. You will cross over the Nick Joe Rahall II Bridge (17th Street West); staying in the left lane, merge onto I-64 East. Continue on I-64; it is 4 miles to Exit #11, Hal Greer Boulevard (16th Street). Turn left at the bottom of the exit ramp. It is 1.8 miles to the entrance to the hospital and medical center on your right.

To St. Mary's Medical Center: Take Route 52 East to I-64. You will cross over the Nick Joe Rahall II Bridge (17th Street West); staying in the left lane, merge onto I-64 East. Continue on I-64; it is 7.5 miles to Exit #15 (29th Street East, Route 60). Follow signs for Route 60 West (left turn onto Route 60 West). Continue for 3.6 miles, turning left at 3rd Avenue/Route 60. Go two blocks and turn right on 29th Street to hospital and outpatient center.

From Louisa, Paintsville & Prestonsburg, KY:

To Cabell Huntington Hospital: Take Route 23 North to I-64. Continue on I-64 East for 11 miles to Exit #11, Hal Greer Boulevard (16th Street). Turn left at the bottom of the exit ramp. It is 1.8 miles to the entrance to the hospital and medical center on your right.

To St. Mary's Medical Center: Take Route 23 North to I-64. Continue on I-64 East for 14 miles to Exit #15, to 29th Street. Make a left turn at the bottom of the exit ramp onto Route 60 West. Continue for 3.6 miles, turning left at 3rd Avenue/Route 60. Go two blocks and turn right on 29th Street to hospital and outpatient center.
